MALAWI UPDATE

So much has happened since we last saw you. We pray all is well in your part of the world, and we want to share some of what's happening in ours. John is the VP of Student Life at York University, which he expertly balances with his role as director over the ministry in Malawi. Jonah is in the Army in North Carolina, Andy is finishing his first year of college, and Ben is planning to begin dual credit high school courses at the university in the fall. I have been doing my best to make a home for us, as I assist the ministry in Malawi and communicate its progress to our friends and supporters here.

We're happy to report that God has blessed this ministry beyond anything we could have imagined. HUGS for Tomorrow* has official non-profit status with the US government, and the village school in Africa has been accredited by the Malawian government. We have established preschool through second grade and feed over 100 kids daily. We own eight acres, six of which is dedicated to food production. That alone offsets the cost of the program by twenty percent, which means the school is already partially self-sufficient even before it's completely developed. For \$200 we are able to feed one child two meals a day for six months—even with the skyrocketing cost of grain. In short, your donations are going towards an extremely efficient pursuit. God has been very good to us.

Our family is planning a trip to Malawi this summer. We have been back in the United States since the pandemic three years ago. Snoden and Susan have asked for us to come, and we feel the need to stay personally in touch with them and with the children in the program. We also plan to bring supplies for the school and to finally




