It is our purpose in using this series of lessons on the Triumphal Entry; the Last Supper; Gethsemane; His Trial, Crucifixion and Resurrection to give special emphasis upon the heart of the Gospel Message. Ultimately Jesus came to give His life a ransom for many. It is His death on the cross, His burial and resurrection that gives us freedom from sin and hope of everlasting life.




